



Notes form Larsen Pavilion Resident Council January 7, 2010 Meeting

Linda Hicks, Activities Leader, called the Resident Council Meeting of January 7 to order at 10:00 am on the third floor. Fifteen residents were in attendance.

Sherry Brown, Administrator

- Sherry informed the residents that the ground preparation has been started to get ready to break ground for the new Rehab center and the Administration building. She mentioned that the East and South side of the building had to be prepared as water retention areas. This preparation was started at the Macoma and Teladora areas. The side walk was taken up and moved to the outside of the perimeter. Within 60 days all areas that have to do with construction will be fenced in.
- Sherry said that Shell Point is still gathering donations for the Administration part of the building. She informed the residents that the Rehab Center would be a great resource for the Shell Point Community. Sherry mentioned that the State surveyors are due anytime. Shell Point strives daily to meet the needs of every individual and the State tells us how we can improve that service. Sherry mentioned that we have new staff members but we also have a majority of regular staff members that have been on their jobs for many years.
- Christine Perdue was recently hired in Activities. She is from West Virginia and has been in Florida for a couple of months.

Margie Pregent, DON

Margie asked the residents how things were going. She introduced Christine Columbo to the residents. Christine talked about her experiences and the fact that she used to be the nurse on the night shift. She said that she would be found circulating the floor frequently because she wanted to make sure things were being taken care of and to get know to all of the residents.

- Margie had mentioned that there were four new CNAs and a new Nurse on the unit.
- Margie told the group that the Pavilion is at the fullest capacity it has had in eight years.

She said that the call lights were still being monitored and the response time was two minutes or less. The administration is still checking to see that resident's needs are being met.

She said that on the third floor call lights have gone off 5,000 times during the month. She said staff would be trying to anticipate the needs of the residents before they needed to use the call lights.

Eva Walczynski, Clinical Coordinator

Eva introduced herself and described her previous duties and indicated she now has taken Kathy Alexander's place as Clinical Coordinator.

Sandi Brower, Kitchen Manager

Sandi asked the residents how their meals were going. They indicated that everything was good. She asked them if they liked the fresh baked bread and the cookies. They all said that those items were very good. She said that a volunteer by the name of Ann Richardson came in on Mondays to bake the cookies.

- Sandi wanted to remind the residents that they were all encouraged to eat in the main dining room and that staff would help them get back and forth.

Abby Rosman, Family and Clinical Services Coordinator

Abby talked about the "Passport Around the World" and that special events would be scheduled to go with the Village wide theme. It would change monthly.

She reminded them of the Gala coming up on the 15th of January. Any resident wishing to go would be taken to the church for the event.

Mary Fountain, Auxiliary First Vice President

- Mary Fountain gave the report for the Auxiliary in Bill Staples absence. She talked about the census being full in the Pavilion and almost full in the other Assisted Living buildings.
- She said Shell Point is looking into the transportation needs of the community.
- She talked about the "Bakeless Bake sale" and how money is generated for the Pavilion.
