- ✿ Linda Hicks, Activities Leader, called the meeting to order. Sixteen residents were in attendance, with four staff. Nita DeWeese, Auxiliary President, was present.
- ✿ Jan Stout, Nurse Manager, reminded residents that their clothing should be labeled by the Laundry Department. Should anything be missing, notify her immediately, as waiting makes it harder to find the wayward item.
- ✿ Margie Pregent, Director of Nursing, reported that "hopefully" the kitchen would be ready by Thanksgiving. Necessary inspections are scheduled for Friday.
- ✿ Margie also said a significant effort in having only Shell Point hired nurses on duty (as versus agency nursing staff) has resulted in the month of October staffed only with employees. She said the Assisted Living buildings were also trying not to use outside services.
- ✿ The second week in December should see the end of the first floor construction. At that point the Dining Room should be open.
- ✿ The Rehab Department and Administration building will be under construction in early 2009.
- ✿ Abby Rosman, Family Services, informed the Council that more and more volunteers are being recruited for programs to accommodate person centered interests. A Word Club will be offered on Friday mornings beginning November 21st.
- ✿ Abby asked the residents what they were thankful for and received a variety of answers, from Shell Point to health to no hurricanes.
- ✿ Linda reminded everyone about the Birthday Bash that afternoon. Also that the senior Olympics will take place next week. All participants will receive a Tee shirt.
- ✿ Ed Scanlon was introduced to the residents. He indicated he would like to be more involved as a representative for the Pavilion.
- ✿ Nita gave the report of the Shell Point Residents' Council.

With no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned at 10:45.
